



Starlab Venue, Sessions & Pricing

Venue Requirements:

Both Starlab Planetarium and Cosmodome require at least one power point, a floor space of 6m x 6m and a ceiling height of 2.8m to 3.8m. A hall, gym or multi-purpose room is ideal otherwise a wind protected undercover area may be used (weather permitting). A standard classroom with desks moved to the edge of the room is normally suitable. Ground level locations with vehicle access are preferred but not essential and access to the site must be restricted during breaks. Set up time is approximately 1 hour and pack down time is approx 30 minutes.

Sessions:

Both the planetarium and cosmodome theatre have a capacity of 30 participants or one class for each session. Stools are provided for adults while a carpeted area is more comfortable for the students. Session duration is between 40 and 60 minutes. Sessions run consecutively allowing for normal school lunch and recess breaks. Multi-year levels are welcome during the same visit. Sessions are tailored to suit the year level of the participants.

Starlab Education recommends the duration of visits to be:

- Full day: 6 x 45 minute sessions or 5 x 1 hour sessions (approx)
- Half day: 4 x 45 minute sessions or 3 x 1 hour sessions
- Night activity: 2 - 3 hours

Prior to the visit, the school will receive support material and worksheets as an additional resource.
