Venue Requirements:

The **Standard Dome** requires at least one power point, a floor space of 6x6 metres and a ceiling height of 3.5 metres (minimum 3 metres). An enclosed hall, gym or multi-purpose room with ground floor vehicle access is ideal.

The **Giant Dome** requires an **enclosed** hall with floor space 9x9m & ceiling height of 4.5m (minimum 3.6 metres) preferably with ground floor, lift or trolley ramp access & close vehicle access. Set up time is approximately 1 hour and pack down time is approximately 30 minutes.

Recommended session duration:

- Half-day Standard Dome - 4 x 40/45-minute or 3x 60-minute sessions (2-4 classes)
- Full-day Standard Dome - 4 x 60-minute, 5 x 50, 6 x 40-minute sessions (4-6 classes)
- Half-day Giant Dome - 3 x 60-minute sessions (or 2 x 60 min session) (4-6 classes)
- Full-day Giant Dome - 4 x 60-minute, 5 x 50-minute sessions (7-10 classes)

Note – Minimum session duration is 40 minutes (Giant dome 50 minutes).

Standard Dome - Maximum 1 class per session (30 primary or 25 high school students)

Giant Dome - Maximum 2 classes per session (60 primary or 50 high school students)

Please complete the timetable to best suit you daily contact times. Sessions run consecutively allowing for the normal recess/lunch breaks. Once a session is in progress, exit and re-entry is restricted. A class teacher is required to attend each session to supervise students inside the dome. For the health and safety of all participants, if a student is not fit to attend school (due to illness) or presents unwell with flu-like symptoms they will not be permitted entry.
